



Community Education SWIM LESSONS FOR KIDS

Welcome to Community Education Swim Lessons! This is the fourth year our department will offer swim lessons. Community Ed has worked very closely with the MJC P.E. department to help create an outstanding program for you to enjoy this summer. I want to take a moment and give you an overview of how our program works and to go over a few housekeeping items.

OUR TEAM

We have four instructors: 3 will be in the water teaching and 1 will be on deck taking care of paperwork, keeping an eye on how the class is progressing and to assist the other two instructors. The On-Deck instructor will also answer any questions or concerns a parent may have regarding the lesson.

WHAT TO BRING

Please make sure your child comes dressed and ready to swim. Bring a towel, and don't forget the sun screen. Floater or swim toys are not necessary. Children must be potty-trained.

LOCKER ROOM

Women and men locker rooms will be open if your child wants to change out of wet clothes after class. PLEASE NOTE: a parent must accompany the child into the locker room. The locker room is also used by adult college students.

PARENTS AREA

We have set up a special bleacher area for you to watch and observe your child. Please remember that this is a tobacco and alcohol free environment. Instructors will NOT allow a child to leave class unless their parent picks them up. Unless you've made arrangements with the instructor please do not send "a friend, neighbor or other kid" to pick up your child.

PARKING

There is free parking on Coldwell Avenue (spaces are limited). If you park on campus you will need a day-pass for \$1. You get the day-pass from the parking permit box in the parking lot put the pass on your dash. The baseball Lot (across from Coldwell) and Lot A (corner of Coldwell and College) require a day-pass.

CLASS CERTIFICATES AND COMPLETION CARDS

The On-Deck instructor will issue Certificates and Completion Cards on the last day of the session. A student can advance to the next level once all 5-key skill areas have been met.
